The Butterfly Effect curated by Chiara Canali

The famous title "The Butterfly Effect", taken from the 2004 film of the same name, according to which the slightest flapping of a butterfly's wings is able to cause a hurricane on the other side of the world ", is a source of inspiration for the design of this curatorial project.

The idea is that small variations in the initial condition produce large variations in the long-term behavior of a system, from climatic to human behavior.

For this reason the artists involved (Lia Pascaniuc, Emilia Faro and Desiderio) present works in which the iconography of the butterfly is not only the pretext for a visual story of great beauty, but it is an opportunity to reflect on the themes of the lightness and fragility of human and natural life.

Man and the living beings of nature need a vital breath that restores them the freedom and hope to plan the future of humanity and nature.

Through the use of the more traditional languages such as painting and sculpture, and the more technological and current ones, such as the hologram, the artists create fragile and delicate works like a butterfly, and through the beating of their wings are able to generate both aesthetic and mental sensations, emotions and reflections.


